General Information

- 1. The deceased was a 63 year old man from the Dublin area.
- The deceased was committed to prison on 6 April 1993. He was serving a life sentence imposed on 11 October 1993. He was on the enhanced level of Incentivised Regime while in prison. He also had good family support.
- He was approved Reviewable Temporary Release on compassionate and medical grounds on 28 March, 2013 having been hospitalised on a number of prior occasions for treatment for a severe medical condition.
- 4. While on Temporary Release the deceased was under the supervision of the Probation Service.
- The deceased passed away on 16 September 2016 in Our Lady's Hospice, Harold's Cross, Dublin 6W.
- 6. The cause of death is a matter for the Coroner.
