The Recommendations submitted by the IOP have been review and considered. The table below is a summary of proposed actions based on the investigation of the IOP in respect of the Irish Prison Service. The table also suggest timelines and action owners for completing the necessary actions.

This will facilitate prisoners to alert staff from all areas of the cell accommodation. This facility will be integrated into any cell allocated for people with disabilities.		New system to be identified and approved by end of May 2021. Installation across the estate to be completed by end OCT 2021.
